Why participate?

Rural areas are emptying out. Young people and families are leaving villages and countryside behind, looking for a future in large cities or abroad.

This phenomenon, known as Rural Exodus, fuels migration and weakens local communities.

We believe that entrepreneurship can be a concrete answer: building new businesses in rural territories, creating dignified and independent jobs, and unlocking local resources through innovation and sustainability.

The EYES Project Facilitation Meetings are an international space for dialogue, collaboration, and cocreation: 4 online sessions to understand the phenomenon, experiment with entrepreneurial tools, and design solutions together.

At the end, participants will be able to continue with the certified online learning paths of EYES Network, turning ideas into real projects.



DEFINING RURAL EXODUS

It is the phenomenon of depopulation in rural areas, caused by the migration of young people and families towards cities and large urban centers in search of jobs, services, and opportunities.

It leads to the loss of human, cultural, and economic capital in rural territories, the increase of inequalities, and growing pressure on urban areas, which become increasingly overcrowded.
